Collaborative Research Sharing

- 2.4 make available, or permit the making available of, Digital Copies to a Collaboration Partner, via a Secure Network, and to print out the same, during the course of and for the purposes of a current Collaborative Project only and provided that the making available of Digital Copies does not amount to a Document Supply service;

Collaborative Research Definitions

Sharing of licensed copies between CLA Licensed HEIs collaborating on a research project.

- **Collaboration Partner:**

a higher education institution which holds either a CLA Higher Education Licence or a CLA Independent Higher Education Licence, as applicable;

- **Collaborative Project:**

a Research Project between the Licensee and one or more Collaboration Partner(s) involving Collaborative Project Persons only;

- **Collaborative Research Persons:**

Authorised persons in:-

ii) all employees of the Licensee,

iii) all individuals who, although not employed by the Licensee, are engaged by it to provide research or consultancy services or who would fall within the meaning of “workers” as defined by the Employment Rights Act 1996,

iv) all Emeritus Professors and other honorary staff and visiting academics; and

students of each Collaboration Partner who are engaged in postgraduate study at either a taught masters or research level.

Changes to Limits

1. **3.4.2** in the case of an article in an issue of a serial publication or in a set of conference proceedings, two (2) whole articles in any single issue or (except for any CCC Electronic-Rights Works), where the issue, or a substantial part of it, is dedicated to a particular theme, any number of articles dealing with that particular theme;
2. the use of different editions of the same book to make copies of more than one (1) chapter during any one Course of Study shall be a breach of the Licence, **except and unless where the content is substantially different;**

What this means for ILL

- Limits and copyright declarations will need to be adjusted for copies provided under CLA Licence e.g. EHES, or for CLA Licence research sharing.
- If researchers wish to share a copy of content not already owned/subscribed to by your institution, a CFP (Copyright Fee Paid) copy should be requested via ILLs.

Fees

Increase of 10% from £7.51 per FTE to £8.27 over 3 year licence period (includes a discount)
